



Scioto Gardens Sites: Landscaping Crew

- Sites Crew members will assist Sites Lead in performing the various services for clients. Sites Lead will work directly with Crew and give instruction, but at times they must also work independently and without direct supervision.
- Sites Lead will provide training to the Crew in the various services offered, with the goal of improving their skill set and to prepare them for advancement as the Landscaping division expands. Sites Crew will also receive training with any tools and equipment required for the work.
- The best applicants will be eager to learn and aim to continually refine their work for quality and efficiency. Crew will also be interacting with clients at times and should be able to maintain a professional demeanor and appearance.

Services include:

- Landscape maintenance including weeding, leaf removal, bed edging, string trimming, soil amendment, and mulching
- Pruning or removal of landscape trees, shrubs, weeds, turf, invasive species, or other undesirable plants (including poison ivy)
- Planting of new plants, including seeds, plugs, pots, and B&B trees
- Installation of decorative boulders, stepping stones, and gravels
- Installation of natural stone retaining walls, including excavation, basing, construction, repair, and hauling of waste
- Installation of other projects such as water features, lighting, drainage, and wildlife habitat creation
- Assist at Scioto Gardens Nursery when field work is not scheduled, per the direction of nursery staff. Duties may include watering, potting, site maintenance, or landscape projects

Applicants must be able to:

- Lift up to 50 lbs to chest height repeatedly
- Maintain good working pace throughout a workday of up to 8 hours
- Drive themselves to and from jobsites around Columbus metro area
- Listen to and follow directions with and without supervision
- Adhere to best safety practices, especially regarding power tools

Scioto Gardens will provide:

Uniform shirts (2 free, additional may be purchased at cost), safety glasses, earplugs, work gloves (2 pair provided free per month), all tools, and equipment to be used.

Applicant must provide:

Work boots that are above ankle and with a safety toe, transportation to and from job sites, packed lunch, ample water (recommended 1 gallon per day), positive attitude, desire to learn, and love of nature.
